Emet, as discussed, I am attaching the mortality records compiled by the Provincial Medical Consultants over the last few years from which all identifying personal information has been removed. Each of these reports is formatted slightly differently depending on the physician or nursing consultant who completed them. Please note that even with due diligence, physicians are not always prepared or able to say with certainty what was the cause of death in all situations.

You also requested information on how deaths of individuals supported by CLBC are reported and reviewed. I would be glad to have a lengthier discussion with you but am pleased to provide an overview:

- All deaths of individuals receiving a CLBC-funded service, regardless of where they occur, are reported by the service provider to CLBC, the Clinical Nursing Consultant and the Provincial Medical Consultant (physician) and family members and legal representatives, as applicable. In addition, Licensing staff under the local health authorities are notified when a death occurs in a home supporting more than 2 individuals.

The medical specialists are employed by the Fraser Health Authority on behalf of all health authorities with a sole focus on health care of individuals with developmental disabilities eligible for CLBC services. Both the physician and the nurse currently holding these positions have a long history and expertise in working with individuals with developmental disabilities. Please let me know if you are interested in receiving the related reporting forms.

- The Coroner is involved in all unexpected or unusual deaths which occur outside a hospital setting as required by law.
- The Nursing Consultant reviews the circumstances of each death to determine whether there are practice issues which might need to be addressed or outcomes which might be applied as learnings for future

situations. She is available to de-brief individual deaths as necessary.

- Where there are potential concerns related to health care management, interpretation of cause of death or the processes followed by medical practitioners in a given community, the Medical Consultant may conduct a more detailed review of the death and may contact the GP, attending physician or emergency room staff.
